# AMENDA NOVEMBR2023 

## 1. NAME

The Cub shall be called The ADRRSDTUNTMOODBOWING OLB and is a Menmers' Oub.

## 2 ATHLATION

The Qub shall be affiliated to Bows England, Bowls Hampshire, the North Hampshire Women's Bowling Association, the Farmham \& Dstrict Bowling Association, the Adershot and District Bowling Association and any other Association deemed appropriate by the Management Committee.

## 3. OBJECTS

The objects of the Qub shall be:

1. The provision and maintenance of a bowling green and Oubhouse at Eggars HIL, Adershot for the use of members

2 The provision of facilities associated with the playing and enjoyment of Bowls
3. The Provision of a programme of social events.

## 4. QLB COLORS AND DRESS

1.The Qub colours are Dark Royal Bue with Red stripes or trimmings

Shirts, Ties, and badges shall be made available at a charge.
2 When on the green all persons shall wear smooth soled heelless footwear.
Dress of players shall be white/cream(whites), or white/creamabove the weist and grey below the waist (greys), or club colours, as indicated in the match details. Tidy casualsmay be used for all informal roll-ups

## 5. MEMEPRSHP.

1. Persons of any age are eligible for membership.

2 There shall be six classes of membership, namely a) Playing, b) Life, c) Junior, d) Social, e) Associate, and f) Friends. Nbte. Juniors are members of under 18 years of age, and Friends are those who have supported and continue to support the Oub financially, but are no longer able to bow.
3. Persons wishing to join will fill in the prescribed formand send, with their payment for the appropriate anmount, to the Honorary Secretary.
4. Formal acceptance of all applications will be at the next meeting of the Management Committee (hereafter referred to as'the MC).
5. Once the payment for membership has been cleared, newmembers will be entitled to the full use of the Oub facilities and privileges, with one exception (see section 7).
6. Mentbers are expected to conduct themselves according to the Rules of Behaviour, as set out in Section 14 of this Constitution.
7. Any breach of these rules will be dealt with in accordance with Section 15 .
8. Members are expected to participate in the activities essential to the smooth running of the club.

## 6. LIEMEMBRSS

Life Membership of the dub may be granted by the unanimous agreement of the MC. Life Menmers will not be required to pay an annual subscription and shall not at any one time exceed five in number.

## 7. SOCALMEMEBS

Social Members may use all the facilities of the Oub with the exception of the Bowling Green, except on any special occasion agreed by the MC However Social Mermbers may use the Bowling Green to take part in the Monday afternoon roll up, or on Monday evenings, on payment of a green fee determined by the Committee.

## 8. ASSOAATEMEMEBRS

The MC. may from time to time determine an annual block subscription for members of a club or organisation whose acceptance as Associate Menbers has been approved by the MC.
1.The annual subscription for all classes of menbership shall be recormended by the MC to be ratified at the Annual General Meeting (hereafter referred to as the AGM. Application forms showing current annual subscriptions shall be posted on the Clubhouse notice board.

2 Subscriptions shall be paid to the Honorary Treasurer by the last day of February each year.
3. If the annual subscription is unpaid by March 31st, notice shall be sent calling attention to a failure to pay. If the annual subscription remains unpaid within fourteen days of this notice, membership shall be terminated If at any time a satisfactory explanation is given to the MC, then the ex-menber, at the discretion of the MC, may be re-admitted upon payment of arrears.

## 10. OLB MANAGEMEN.

The management of the Cub shall be vested in the Management Committee.

## 11. MANAGEMENTCOMMTIE

1. The MC. will manage the Cub on behalf of the Menbers, and exercise its powers in accordance with these rules, and shall have due regard to any resolution or recommendation of any General Meeting.

2 The MC shall consist of the President, Vice-President, Chairman, Honorary Secretary, Assistant Honorary Secretary/Membership Secretary, Honorary Treasurer, Men's Captain, Women's Captain, Match Secretary, Competition Secretaries, Green Manager, and the Bar Manager(s) (the Officers of the Qub), together with two playing menbers duly elected at the AGM
If a Captain cannot attend a meeting, the relevant Vice Captain may deputise.
MC. members shall hold office until the next AGM but shall then be eligible for re-election
3. There shall be a President and a Vice President, elected annually at the AGM
4. The offices of Honorary Secretary and Honorary Treasurer, the Qub Executive Officers shall be held by either a man or a woman The Hbnorary Secretary and Honorary Treasurer shall deal with all Qub members.
5. The MC. shall have power at any time to fill any vacancy on the Conmittee, and any member so appointed shall hodd office only until the next AGM, and shall then be eligible for election.
6. The Honorary Secretary or in their absence, any person appointed by the MC, shall take minutes of all AGMs, Spring meetings, MC, meetings and Extraordinary meetings
These minutes shall be available from the Honorary Secretary for inspection on application, and shall be displayed on the notice board at the relevant time.
7. The MC shall meet as required, and not less than four times each year. A quorum shall be five in number.
8. The Honorary Treasurer shall keep all records of the Qub finances, and prepare a Statement of Accounts for each twelve months ending September 30th The Statement of Accounts shall be audited by one member elected at the AGM
9. Any emergency requiring immediate action and the spending of funds, will be put to the 'Emergency Sub Committee', comprising the Honorary Secretary, The Hbnorary Treasurer, and the Green Manager. Decisions made will be put to the next MC meeting.

## 12 BORROWNGS

The MC shall not borrow money for the Qub activities in excess of $50 \%$ of the total annual members subscriptions without the prior approval of Members at a General Meeting.

## 13. TRUSI世TS

1. Trustees, in law, do not need to be appointed, but if they are, the property of the Oub shall be vested in them If appointed, they will be ex-officio members of the MC

2 The Trustees, if appointed, shall be appointed by the MC, and shall be indermified against risk and expense out of the Qub property.
Any Trustees appointed have no specific powers, and act only as directed by the MC.
Trustees shall hold office until death or resignation, or until removed from office by a resolution of the MC.
If by reason of any such death, resignation or removal it is necessary to appoint a newTrustee, the MC shall by resolution nominate the person or persons to be appointed
3. For the purpose of giving effect to such nominations, the Chairman of the Qub is hereby nominated as the person to appoint newTrustees on behalf of the MC. within the meaning of the Trustee Act 1925, and a copy of such appointment shall be filed in the Qub file for Trustees'.

## 14. OONOCTOFMMEBS

1. All menbers are expected to maintain the principles of good conduct, loyalty, harmony, sportsmanship and fellowship within the Qub and while representing the Qub at other venues.

2 Any complaint against a member accused of breaking the Oub Rules, misconduct or unsporting behaviour shall be submitted to the Ohairman in writing and shall be dealt with as quickly as possible by the President.
3. The President shall delegate a sub-cormittee of three menbers of the MC (to include one man and one woman).

The sub committee will consider the complaint and if necessary interviewboth the complainant and the complainee, and recommend to the MC. what if any action should be taken.
4. The MC. will have the power to accept, amend or reject the findings of the sub cormittee, after due consideration.
5. If the MC decides that the matter is potentially a Dsciplinary Matter, action will be in accordance with paragraph 15 below. If the complaint does not relate to a disciplinary matter, the MC. will attempt to resolve the matter amicably between the parties concerned

## 15. SAFGUARDNGANDDSCPUNARYMATIRS

We adopt and followall policies and guidelines approved by Bowls England and UKAnti-Doping. We followall procedures set out in Bowls England Regulation 9, 9A and 9B We will abide with all sanctions, recommendations and/or decisions fromthe Safeguarding Case Management Panel or National Dsciplinary Pane."'
16. GUESTS

Any member shall be entitled to introduce personal guests to the Qub provided that no person whose application for membership has been Previously declined or who has been suspended or expelled from the Qub shall be introduced as a guest.
The member introducing the guest shall be responsible for the guest strictly observing the Qub Rules, and be responsible for ensuring that the Visitors Book kept in the Qubhouse is signed by the member and the guest.

## 17. ANUALGERALM巴TING

1. There shall be an Annual General Meeting of the Club, and fifteen months must not elapse without such a meeting

Notification of date shall be included in the Qub Booklet for the relevant year, and a copy exhibited on the Oub Nbtice Board with a nomination sheet duly prepared for the election of Officers and Cormittee Menbers, one month before the date of the Meeting.

2 At this meeting the following business shall be conducted
a) The presentation and, if accepted, the passing of the audited accounts
b) The election of Officers and Members tothe Management Conmittee.
c) To agree the subscriptions for the year
d) Amendments and Propositions to the Constitution of which fourteen days notice, in writing, has been given to the Honorary Secretary. Such Amendments and Propositions may be made only by full members.

## 18. EXTRAORDINARY GENRALMIIINGS

1. These meetings may be convened at any time by the MC. or upon the request of not less than five playing menbers, or $10 \%$ of the total playing members, whichever shall be the greater.
2. VOTING

Voting at the AGM and any Extraordinary General Meeting shall be confined to the full playing members of the Oub aged eighteen or over. Every playing member shall be entitled to be present and vote once only upon every question or motion calling for a decision by vote. The Chairman will have a casting vote only.

## 20. SPRINGM $\boxplus$ ING

1. The Spring meeting shall be held early in the calendar year and shall be deemed to be a General Meeting of the Oub.

2 The following business shall be conducted
a) Bection of the Entertainment and Catering Organisers and the Winter Captain
b) Any other business

## 21. SUB-COMMITIES

The Bar Manager/s, Green Manager and - if it exists the Entertainment Organiser - shall report to the MC at each Committee Meeting, or as requested by the Chairman
Nb expenses shall be incurred or new policy introduced by any of the managers without the prior approval of the MC

22 BARMANAGR（S）
1．The Bar Manager／s and members operating the Bar on a rota shall have access to the Bar keys and be authorised to open the Bar，and conduct Business strictly in conformity with the Qub Rules and Licensing Regulations．

2 The Bar Manager／s shall be responsible for maintaining an adequate stock in liaison with the Horarary Treasurer．An account of all purchases and sales shall be maintained and verification of stocks should be made regularly during the playing season．

3．Nbintoxicating liquor shall be consumed other than inside the Qubhouse and on the forecourt．In no circumstances shall consumption be allowed on the Bowling Green

4．Nb intoxicating liquor shall be supplied to any person under the age of 18 ，and to no person over 18 who is not a Oub member or bona fide guest．
5．The Bar Manager／s shall be responsible for notifying the Honorary Secretary respecting the acquisition，extension and maintenance of any necessary notice or licence for the purchase and sale of intoxicating liquor and shall apply the foregoing rules sofar as applicable to the trade and include such transactions in the financial statement．

## 23．GR $⿴ 囗 十$ NMANAGR

1．The Green Manager shall be responsible for managing the inspection，maintenance，repair and general condition of the Bowling Green and surrounds，including oversight of any outside Contractors．

2 Play shall be delayed or suspended entirely when adverse weather or other conditions shall，in the opinion of the Green Manager or in their absence a member of the MC，consider it is in the interests of the Qub to do so and for such periods as they think fit．

## 24．COMPEITIONS \＆SEACTION COMMITIES

1．The Selection Cormittees shall comprise Captain，Vice Captain and a selector
2 The relevant Captain shall，in consultation with the Selection Com mittee，decide a fixed day of the week for selection meetings
3．At all meetings two menbers shall forma quorum
4．The Selection Cormittee for＇Friendly fixtures shall comprise up to three members from24．1．Two members shall forma quorum
5．If only one Selection Conmittee member is available，then a Committee member may be co－opted
6．For League and other Competitive Matches，the Selection Cormittees shall select the best players available who shall be determined according to current form performance or results．The Selection Conmittees shall be mindful that all players have differing levels of performance during the season and fromyear to year．

## 25．BNIRTAMMENT ORGANSER

The Entertainment Organiser，who is elected at the Spring Meeting，will be responsible for the organisation and provision of all social activities and functions as agreed by the MC．Any gains arising fromsuch functions shall be passed to the Honrary Treasurer as soon as possible to be included in the Qub＇s accounts

## 26．OLB RPRRESENATIVES

Representatives to Affiliated bodies shall be appointed by the MC．These will be known as＇Delegates＇．

## 27．APP ICATIONOFFUNS

Nbmoney or property of the Qub or any gain arising fromthe activities of the Qub shall be applied other than for the benefit of the Qub， excluding small charitable donations．

## 28．REVOCATION AND MDOACATION OF RUES

These Rules may be added to，revoked，amended or replaced by resolution at any General Meeting，provided that no such resolution shall be deemed to have been passed unless carried by a majority of not less than two thirds of the total full playing members present and voting at the Meeting

29．EXCLLION OF OLB RROM LABITY．
Neither the Qub nor any Officer thereof shall be liable to any member or guest for any loss or damage to any property occurring on the Qub premises，nor any injury sustained by any member or guest whilst on the Oub premises．

## 30. LABLITY OF THE OPTCRS OF THE QLB

Anotice on the terms set out above shall be displayed at all times on the Oub notice board The Qub Insurance will compensate any Officer of the Oub or Menber acting under the direction of an Officer of the Qub for claims made against that person in the proper performance of the duties as an Officer or under the directions of an Officer of the Qub.

## 31. INDEMTTY

Each member of the Oub shall - to the extent that such person is not entitled to recover under any policy of Insurance - be entitled to be indermified out of any and all funds available to the Qub, which may lawfully be so applied, against all costs, expenses and liabilities whatsoever incurred by such person in the proper execution and discharge of duties undertaken on behalf of the Qub or arising therefrom or incurred in good faith in the purported discharge of such duties.

32 INITRPRETATION OF RUES
The MC. shall be the sole authority for the interpretation of these rules and of the regulations made fromtime to time by the MC, and with the exception of Rule 16, the decision of the MC. upon any question of interpretation or upon any matter affecting the Oub and not provided for by these Rules or by the regulations shall be final and binding on the Members.

## 33. ISSOLUION

If at any General Meeting a resdution for the dissolution of the Qub shall be passed by a mejority of members present and such resolution shall at an Extraordinary General Meeting held not less than one month thereafter at which not less than half the Menbers shall be present be confirmed by a resolution passed by a majority of two thirds of the Merbers voting thereon, the MC, shall thereupon or at such future date as shall be specified in such resolution, proceed to realise the property of the Qub and after the discharge of all liabilities shall divide the same among all the full playing members and life members in proportion to their years of Membership subject to a maximum of ten years Upon the completion of such division the Qub shall be dissolve.
